Motion by Merrill, supported by Rollenhagen, to pay the monthly bills; AIF; Motion carried.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

Myers Road Ending - Merrill talked with Mr. Sohlden, Road Commission Manager, and he is not sure if the road ending can be blocked off as space has to be available for walking/snowmobiles. It is the responsibility of the township to enforce the ordinance. Merrill will send a letter to Steve Allen addressing boat use at the road-ending. The Township's road-ending ordinance is specific – no boats, launching or hoists.

Motion by Rollenhagen, supported by Monk, to approve Resolution No. 9-12-2016 Regional Resource Recovery Project, a sustainable resource recovery/recycling program (to expand acceptable items for recycling), whereas the AES and the consulting project director, Iris Waste Diversion Specialist, is seeking collaboration in the project from neighboring governmental units, and who have not been asked to provide funding to participate in the project, with the understanding that Pleasanton Township may withdraw from the project at any time; roll-call vote – ayes: Girven, Monk, Rollenhagen, Merrill, Cross; Motion carried.
