<i>Prior meeting minutes</i>	March 20, 2023, Meeting Minutes presented.	<i>Motion by Erdman, second by Gauthier, to approve minutes. All in favor, motion carried.</i>
<i>Park(s) Update</i>	<p>Buell Park —Updates provided by Merrill, <b>Ramp/Cement</b> – partly washed out, Merrill discussed with Pat at Spicer Group. Cost to repair \$3,900.00. Originally the group noted Mobi Mat and Spicer recommended cement.</p> <p><b>Kiosk Sign</b> – Sent email to Spicer group on two sides on which they were working.</p> <p><b>Rules Sign</b> – Merrill to get quote.</p> <p><b>Road Commission</b> – Have not met.</p> <p><b>Fence</b> – Black is the color decided. Merrill to check on order and it should take four (4) weeks to order and install.</p> <p><b>Buoys</b> – these are in and ready to be installed. Cement bases at park. Merrill has someone who volunteered to install.</p> <p><b>Light</b> – Consumers Energy will be hooking up electricity the first week in May.</p> <p><b>Shed</b> – Discussed pea gravel vs repurposed gravel or cement slab. The group decided pea gravel was a good option.</p> <p>Merrill to check at Pahls for an 8 x 10.</p> <p><b>Folding Bench for bathroom</b> - Gauthier brought pictures of bench at Onekama rest room. Same as the one Merrill had already suggested.</p> <p><b>Rain Garden</b> – A car was doing donuts in the parking lot over the winter and went into the rain garden.</p>	

	<p><b>Donation</b> – We received a \$5,000 donation from a resident for the park. Group to discuss a beneficial use for this donation.</p> <p><b>DNR / EGLE</b> – Reimbursement on the grant has come in. They will hold 10% until the project is complete.</p> <p>If additional money is required, we also have the ARPA money.</p> <p><b>Ribbon Cutting</b> – hopefully, we will know more in the next month.</p>	
<b>Township Hall/ Park</b>	<p><b>Pickleball court</b> – Erdman suggested wind screens for the pickleball court. These would be for the South and West ends of the court. Tarps were tested out and shredded. Erdman brought quotes from two vendors and a recommendation from Douglas Sports. The total cost of \$1,525.00. Merrill will take to the board meeting for discussion/approval.</p> <p><b>Porta Potty</b> – will be back at the township hall the end of month/May 1<sup>st</sup> through September.</p>	<i>Merrill to take cost information on screens/netting for pickleball court to next board meeting for discussion/approval.</i>
