Speed Limit 25 ahead – we are responsible for permits needed.

Awaiting samples from MDOT. • Dedication planned for June 14th, 2024. Mid-afternoon 2-5 pm, with cake and drinks. • Week prior to dedication – workshop to clean park. • Rain Garden – Watershed is responsible for upkeep. • Buoys will be installed when the weather/water warms a bit. Due to warranty five (5) new buoys are in the shed to install. • Road – End Signs – Swim at own risk need replacement. • Fence at Dayton Club – needs fixing. This is the Dayton Club's fence. • Discussed Beach Sand needed, recommended 20 yards. • Discussed rail or bump stop on cement pad to stop a wheelchair from rolling into the lake. • Rocks – Discussed moving of the rocks. • Cross Walk Signs – Merrill to check with Road Commission regarding cross walk signs and adjustment.
